

Logan Canyon Construction

Beginning the first week of August, access to the nature center will be affected by construction on the first three bridges in Logan Canyon—Mouth of Canyon Bridge, Middle Bridge, and Right Hand Fork Bridge. The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) and Wadsworth Construction has made it a priority to maintain access to SNC but there will be delays and road restrictions. According to UDOT, flaggers will be monitoring traffic and delays of 5-10 minutes should be expected during weekday working hours. Coordinated and closely monitored traffic lights will keep canyon traffic flowing as smoothly as possible. In addition, UDOT requests that we be prepared for these delays and to please drive safely and follow the work zone speed limit of 30 MPH.

Once restrictions are in place, the bridges mentioned above will have no shoulder. Watch for pedestrians and bicyclists who must merge with traffic over the bridges.

The good news is we will stay open and continue with our programs! Parking for Stokes Nature Center will be limited to the north side of HWY 89 next to the large “Cache National Forest” sign. There will be NO PARKING on the south side of HWY 89 for SNC visitors or River Trail users. Student drop-off and pick-up will be affected and we will provide our program participants with specific instructions for attending SNC programs or you can call SNC at 435-755-3239. SNC staff, volunteers, and visitors who need accessible parking will be allowed to drive to the nature center building but please anticipate delays.
